BUILDING WITH A PURPOSE

Set off for a cultural adventure in Ho Chi Minh City!
Accommodation at a five-star hotel located in the heart of Saigon.

DAY 1

Upon arrival at Tan Son Nhat International Airport, set off for lunch at Indochine Restaurant. The charming architecture of the restaurant is inspired by the typical colonial Vietnamese houses of the 19th century.

After lunch, embark on a half day sightseeing tour of the Colonial City Hall, Dong Khoi street area, Notre Dame Cathedral, Central Post Office, the Reunification Palace, and War Museum.

In the evening, set sail on a dinner cruise aboard a traditional Indochinese junk! Unwind in the relaxing atmosphere of the cruise, and watch an 'East Meets West' performance by the six-member Hoa Mai band. This band plays exotic instruments such as the stone-xylophone, clapping bamboo, Champa-drums, 36-string guitar, Chinese guitar and mono-string violin, entertaining the audience with classic rock tunes amid the junk's oriental setting.

DAY 2

Break up into teams and embark on a half-day Saigon adventure! Go on a cultural expedition, or compete in a battle of wits and strategies akin to what a Cu Chi guerrilla would have experienced!

Building with a Purpose (Half Day Programme)

Option 1 – Explore Vietnamese Culture

Each team will get around the city via a unique mode of Vietnamese transportation. This tour provides the rare opportunity to learn about the four most significant types of Vietnamese cultural performances and art. At random places in the city, teams will learn, practise and compete with one another on their knowledge of local arts, from water puppetry, Tai Chi exercises, martial arts, Vietnamese cuisine, to Vietnamese history.

The team that scores the highest points for the performance of all the activities will be the winner.

Option 2 - The Cu Chi Guerrillas

Experience life through the eyes of a Cu Chi guerrilla! Teams need to work together to overcome challenges that test participants' determination, resourcefulness and patriotism –admirable characteristics of the Vietnamese guerrillas which contributed to the country's victory in the Vietnam War.

After the day's activities, unwind with dinner at Nam Phan Zen, a converted colonial villa right in the heart of the city. Then, proceed for a tour of the Night Market before retreating to your hotel for a good night's rest.

DAY 3

Spend the day at leisure before departing for your onward flight back to Singapore.
